NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028*.
- 1.2 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing instructions, and any supplementary sailing instructions that will be posted on the official notice board located at Corsica River Yacht Club.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Competitor advertising will not be restricted.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Portsmouth classes.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Required fees are as follows:

Free for club members recommended \$5 donation for Club Guests.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration: Any race Day from 17:00 to 17:30 or by email to PRO.
- 5.2 Dates of racing:
May 15 - Aug 28
- 5.3 Number of races:
16 races scheduled.
- 5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 18:30.

6 MEASUREMENT

- 6.1 Each boat shall produce a valid Portsmouth rating or arrange for one with the PRO.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after May 1 at CRYC club or on the CRYC Facebook page or prior to racing each week.

8 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows: The course each night will be provided and will be a combination of fixed and dropped marks in the Corsica River and Chester river. The approximate course length will be 4 NM.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 9.1 The Scoring Penalty, RRS 44.3, will apply.
- 9.2 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 The scoring system is as follows: High point appendix A.
- 10.2 To qualify for inclusion in the final series results a boat shall come to the starting area for at least 30 percent of the completed races listed in NOR.
- 10.3 Define 'N' to be the number of boats that compete in a particular race. Each boat finishing a race and not thereafter retiring, being penalized or given redress will be scored as follows:

<u>Finishing place</u>	<u>Points</u>
First	N
Second	N-1
Third	N-2
Fourth	N-3
Each place thereafter	Subtract 1 point

All other boats that compete in that race, including any that finish and thereafter retire or are disqualified, will score 0 points. Boats that do not compete in that race (DNC) will not be scored.

- 10.4 The series score for each boat will be a percentage calculated as follows: divide the sum of her race scores by the sum of the points she would have scored if she had placed first in every race in which she competed; multiply the result by 100. The qualified boat with the highest series score is the winner, and others are ranked accordingly. [Each boat's [worst score][<number> worst scores] will be excluded. An excluded race counts as a race to qualify a boat for a series score but not as one of her scored races.]

19 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: First through Third for the full series.

20 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

21 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 50,000 per incident or the equivalent.
