NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority (OA) for this regatta is Corsica River Yacht Club (CRYC)

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028*. And the North American Portsmouth Yardstick.
- 1.2 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing instructions, and any supplementary sailing instructions that will be posted on the official notice board located at Corsica River Yacht Club.
- 1.3 Rule 60.4(a)(2) is changed as follows: (2) if it alleges a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 and is from a boat that was not involved in, and did not see, the incident, or...

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Competitor advertising will not be restricted.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Portsmouth classes.

4 FEES

- 4.1 *Required fees are as follows:*
Free for club members, recommended \$5 donation for Club Guests.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration: Any race Day from 17:00 to 17:30 or by email to PRO.
- 5.2 Dates of racing:
May 21 – Sep 3
- 5.3 Number of races:
16 races scheduled.
- 5.4 Skipper meeting and course information 18:00 near the RC shed.
- 5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 18:30.

6 MEASUREMENT

- 6.1 Each boat shall have a valid Portsmouth rating or arrange one with the PRO prior to sailing.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after May 1 at CRYC club or prior to racing each week.

8 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows: The course each night will be announced it will be a combination of fixed and dropped marks in the Corsica River and Chester River. The approximate course length will be 4 NM. One race each night counts for the series.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1 The Scoring Penalty, RRS 44.2, will apply.

9.2 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

10 SCORING

10.1 The scoring system is as follows: High point appendix A.

10.2 Define 'N' to be the number of boats that compete in a particular race. Each boat finishing a race and not thereafter retiring, being penalized or given redress will be scored as follows:

<u>Finishing place</u>	<u>Points</u>
First	N
Second	N-1
Third	N-2
Fourth	N-3

Each place thereafter Subtract 1 point

All other boats that compete in that race, including any that finish and thereafter retire or are disqualified, will score 0 points. Boats that do not compete in that race (DNC) will not be scored.

10.4 The series score for each boat will be a percentage calculated as follows: divide the sum of her race scores by the sum of the points she would have scored if she had placed first in every race in which she competed; multiply the result by 100. The qualified boat with the highest series score is the winner, and others are ranked accordingly.

19 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: First through Third for the full series.

20 DISCLAIMERS OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
