NOTICE of RACE

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.2 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing instructions, and any supplementary sailing instructions that will be posted on the official notice board located at Corsica River Yacht Club.

1.3 Rule 60.4(a)(2) is changed as follows: (2) if it alleges a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 and is from a boat that was not involved in, and did not see, the incident, or...

1.4 The US Sailing Prescriptions added to the Preamble of Part 5 Section B and to RRS 63.1 will not apply.

3 COMMUNICATIONS

3.1 The online official notice board is located at

3.2 [NP] All boats are recommended to carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on USA channels.

3.3 [NP] On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The specific channel will be stated in the SIs.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 The event is open to all boats of the Comet, Windmill, Hampton, Penguin (Saturday only), A-Cat, Sunfish, Traditional Cat rig Boat, Albacore and any recognized by the Portsmouth class boat.

4.2 For a class to have a class start, it must be a minimum of 4 valid entries by 0930 on Friday day, July 19 . Entry for boats in classes that fail to meet the minimum may be moved to a Portsmouth class or refunded at the discretion of the Regatta Committee

4.3 Boats wishing to enter shall enter by registering at the Regatta Network site <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/31189>

4.4 To be considered a valid entry in the event, a boat shall complete all entry requirements including the payment of all fees.

5 FEES

5.1 Penguin Class :\$50.00 Saturday Only and No dinners provided with registration.

5.2 All Single handed classes Sailing both days, A-Cats, Sunfish or others: \$80.00 No Dinners provided.

5.3 All other classes, Albacore Comet Windmill Hamptons Traditional Cat boat: \$100.00 No Dinners provided.

Coffie, Tea, OJ and breakfast items available Saturday and Sunday morning for all.

5.4 Dinner tickets for Saturday night Dinner and music will be \$40.00 each when purchased before July 20, After that date dinners will be \$45 as available. **Dinners are not included with boat Registration.**

6 SCHEDULE

6.1 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of the regatta is 1000 Saturday July 25.

6.2. For classes only sailing on Saturday, no warning signal will be made after 1630 July 25.

6.3 For sailing classes on both days, no warning signal will be made after 1530 July 26.

6.4 A post-race social and trophy presentation will take place as soon as possible after racing at the Corsica River Yacht Club. Hotdogs and Burgers will be available on Sunday.

6. Up to 5 races at max per day.

7 VENUE

7.1 The racing area will be the Corsica River and the Chester River as conditions require.

8 COURSES

8.1 The courses to be sailed will be windward / leeward drop mark courses.

8.2 For traditional Cat boats and other Portsmouth boats a fixed mark Radom leg course may be used.

9. Penalties

9.1 RRS44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty

10 Scoring

10.1 A boat's Series score shall be the total of her race scores.

11 RISK STATEMENT

11.1 The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

The **C. Lowndes Johnson Perpetual Trophy** and the **Comet Championship Trophy** will be awarded at the Regatta.

The **Temple Blackwood Memorial Trophy** for the best Penguin.
